## ANNOUNCEMENT

In partial modification of Announcement dated 12.04.2023, it is hereby announced for the general information of the candidates who have applied for the posts of Assistant District Attorney (Group-B) in Prosecution Department, Haryana against Advertisement No. 14/2023 dated 22.02.2023 followed by corrigendum dated 25.05.2023 that the Scheme/Pattern of Exam has been amended as detailed below:-

### Scheme/Pattern of Exam:-

#### 1. Screening Test

- a) Total number of MCQs: 100  
(i) Around 80% of the total questions will be from the syllabus as detailed below:-

##### a) Civil Law

- i) Code of Civil Procedure
- ii) Indian Evidence Act
- iii) Indian Contract Act
- iv) Indian Partnership Act
- v) Sale of Goods Act
- vi) Hindu Law
- vii) Mohammadan Law and Customary Law.

##### b) Criminal Law

- i) Indian Penal code
- ii) Criminal Procedure Code
- iii) Indian Evidence Act

Remaining questions will be from the topics of General Awareness, General Mental Ability, Comprehension, Logical Reasoning and Analytical Ability, Decision making and problem solving, Basic numeracy, Data interpretation and the questions related to History, Geography, Polity, Economy and Culture of Haryana.

- b) Total Marks: 100  
c) Time duration of the exam: 02 hours  
d) All questions carry equal marks.  
e) Each question will have five options. The fifth option will be meant for a situation where a candidate intends to leave the question un-attempted.  
f) One-fourth mark will be deducted for each wrong answer.  
g) In case, a candidate neither attempts a question nor darkens the fifth option/bubble, then One-fourth mark will be deducted for each such question.  
h) The medium of Examination will be in English and Hindi.

- i) A candidate will have to secure a minimum of 25% marks to clear the screening test.
- j) Candidates four times the number of advertised posts, category-wise alongwith bracketed candidates, if any, will be called for the Subject Knowledge Test, provided that they have secured the minimum cutoff marks of 25%.
- k) The marks obtained by the candidates in the screening test will not be counted for final selection because it is meant only for short-listing of category-wise candidates.

## 2. Subject Knowledge Test

- a) Time duration of exam: 03 hours
- b) Syllabus is as detailed below:-

### a) Civil Law

- i) Code of Civil Procedure
- ii) Indian Evidence Act
- iii) Indian Contract Act
- iv) Indian Partnership Act
- v) Sale of Goods Act
- vi) Hindu Law
- vii) Mohammadan Law and Customary Law.

### b) Criminal Law


- i) Indian Penal code
- ii) Criminal Procedure Code
- iii) Indian Evidence Act

- c) The medium of Examination will be in English and Hindi.
- d) Total Marks: 150
- e) Paper will be subjective type.
- f) No candidate will be called for the interview/viva-voce test unless she/he secures a minimum of 35% marks in the test.
- g) The numbers of the candidates called for interview will be two times, alongwith bracketed candidates if any, of the number of category-wise advertised posts provided that they have secured the minimum cut-off marks of 35%.
- h) The weight-age of the Subject Knowledge Test will be 87.5%

## 3. Interview

- a) The weight age of the interview will be 12.5%.
4. The final merit list will be prepared by adding the marks of Subject Knowledge Test and interview.
