- It is situated at an altitude of **2450 meters** at the observatory, which lies at the campus of Aryabhatta Research Institute of Observational Sciences.
- The ILMT employs a 4-meter-diameter rotating mirror, which was made up of a thin layer of liquid mercury, to collect and focus light.

> FINLAND BECOMES 31ST MEMBER OF NATO

- The Secretary General of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO), Jens Stoltenberg has informed that Finland has become the 31st member of the alliance.
- Turkey's approval has allowed the **extension of NATO.**
- Finland shares a long border (over 1,300 kilometers) with Russia, and its decision to join NATO was prompted by security concerns following Russia's invasion of Ukraine in 2022.
- However, **Turkey and Hungary** have declined Sweden's application to join **NATO**.
- NATO was established in 1949 with the signing of the North Atlantic Treaty in Washington D.C.
- **Aim:** Collective defense against potential Soviet aggression.
- This means attacks on all member countries, and all members are obliged to respond to such an attack.

- AIIMS was established in 1956, under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India.
- The **first AIIMS** was established in **New Delhi**, and currently, there are a total of 9 AIIMS institutes in India.

> FIRST GLOBAL BUDDHIST SUMMIT

- PM Modi will inaugurate the first Global Buddhist Summit in New Delhi on April 20, 2023.
- Theme 2023: Responses to Contemporary Challenges: Philosophy to Praxis
- Ministry of Culture and its grantee body International Buddhist • Hosted by: Confederation.
- Buddhism was founded by **Siddhartha Gautama**, also known as the Buddha, who lived in the 5th century BCE in what is now **Nepal and northern India**.
- The Buddhist scriptures, known as the **Tripitaka or Three Baskets**, are written in **Pali**, Sanskrit, and other languages and contain the teachings of the Buddha and his followers.

> OPERATION KAVERI:

- **Purpose:** to evacuate its stranded citizens from Sudan.
- Aircrafts used: Two C-130s aircraft and the navy ship INS Sumedha.
- Sudan rescue ops named Operation Kaveri like Ukraine rescue ops named Operation Ganga.
- **Planned by:** Indian Armed Forces and Ministry of External Affairs
- Kaveri is one of the major Indian rivers flowing through Karnataka and Tamil Nadu.

- RBI announced to withdraw Rs. 2000 denomination notes from circulation on 19 May,
 2023.
- The Note will continue to remain as legal tender.
- The Note can be **exchanged or deposited** in bank accounts till **September 30, 2023**, after which it will **not be a legal tender.**
- The decision is taken under RBI's Clean Note Policy.
- The policy aims to remove all counterfeit and mutilated notes from circulation.
- The Note was introduced on 8th November 2016 under Section 24 (1) of RBI Act, 1934.
- RBI Founded: **1 April 1935**; RBI Nationalized: **1 January 1949**; HQ: **Mumbai**; RBI Governor: **Shaktikanta Das** (25th).
- Earlier Instances of Demonetisation:
- 1946: Rs 500, Rs 1000, and Rs 10,000 notes demonetized
- 1978: Rs 1,000, Rs 5,000 and Rs 10,000 notes are demonetized
- **2014:** Notes issued before 2005 withdrawn
- **2016:** Rs 500, Rs 1000 notes demonetised

➤ <u>INDIA's NEW PARLIAMENT:</u>

- Inaugurated by: PM Narendra Modi.
- Installed a historic sceptre 'Sengol' near the Lok Sabha Speaker's chair.
- The 'Sengol' was first given to the first PM of India, Jawaharlal Nehru.
- The Sengol represents a symbol of the transfer of power from the British Government to India.
- The idea of Sengol was the brainchild of C.Rajagopalachari, who was inspired by the Chola Dynasty.
- The "sengol" was created by the Chennai-based jeweller **Vummidi Bangaru Chetty.**
- The "sengol" is five feet long staff with its top adorned by Nandi.
