Detailed Descriptions of the Passes:

1. **Asirgarh (Madhya Pradesh):** Though not a typical mountain pass, Asirgarh is historically significant and serves as a strategic location in Madhya Pradesh.
2. **Auden's Col (Uttarakhand):** A high-altitude pass in the Garhwal region of Uttarakhand, known for challenging trekking routes. It's a difficult pass to cross due to its extreme elevation.
3. **Banihal Pass (Jammu and Kashmir):** Connects the Kashmir Valley with Jammu. It is an important pass that plays a significant role in transportation between these two regions.
4. **Bara-lacha-la (Himachal Pradesh):** Located in the Zaskar range, this pass connects Lahaul with Ladakh and is often crossed by the Manali-Leh highway.
5. **Bomdila (Arunachal Pradesh):** A lesser-known pass in Arunachal Pradesh, it's important for access to various parts of the state.
6. **Changla Pass (Ladakh):** One of the highest motorable passes in the world, it connects Leh with the Changthang plateau.
7. **Chanshal Pass (Himachal Pradesh):** Provides access between the villages of Dodra Kwar in Rohru, it's a high-altitude pass in the Shimla district.
